Eight Days of Hope, Inc., was formed in response to the devastation along the Mississippi Gulf Coast as a result of Hurricane Katrina in August 2005. Stephen Tybor, Jr., of Buffalo, New York, and his son, Stephen Tybor III planned to bring a few of their friends and colleagues in the building materials industry for a few days to help homeowners rebuild. From this simple vision a ministry opportunity for thousands of people was born.

Thousands of volunteers from across the United States and several foreign countries have come together to assist homeowners. Individuals and families from across the country have joined others in working with Eight Days of Hope, Inc. All able-bodied individuals work with us and each has a special place in the effort. Eight Days of Hope, Inc., provides lodging and food for the volunteers. Because this ministry is involved in re-construction efforts individuals with skills in the construction trades are essential, but anyone willing to learn and follow instructions is used.



Eight Days of Hope, Inc., is currently focusing its resources and efforts in rebuilding the Mississippi Gulf Coast and Southwest Louisiana in the aftermath of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita. Our volunteers are prepared and committed to going anywhere in the United States to respond to the needs of those affected by disaster and loss.

In addition, Eight Days of Hope has begun Community Enrichment weeks in which our volunteers will go to a community anywhere in the United States to help homeowners make repairs in an effort to eliminate substandard housing. Eight Days of Hope will again partner with local agencies and churches who are on the front lines of these efforts day to day.

In partnering with local organizations, churches, and government agencies Eight Days of Hope, Inc., seeks roofing materials, electrical supplies, furniture, and other building supplies.
