EIGHT DAYS OF HOPE TO ASSIST MAUI, HI, FOLLOWING WILDFIRES

Tupelo, MS – Eight Days of Hope (EDOH) is responding to the catastrophic devastation caused by wildfires in Maui, HI, which have resulted in almost 100 deaths and an estimated \$6 billion dollars of losses.

"The damage is horrific, and the community is hurting. Eight Days of Hope is committed to loving and serving those impacted through the local church to bring healing and restoration to as many as possible," says Stephen Tybor III, EDOH President and CEO.

EDOH is partnering with multiple local churches to spread resources to those across the island, including water, food, diapers, clothing, cots, storage units, and other material necessities.

"We are here at our makeshift donation center that we opened Friday to support those who just lost everything in the fires.
