EIGHT DAYS OF HOPE – BUFFALO 2024 COMING TO ELLICOTT DISTRICT

Buffalo, NY – Eight Days of Hope (EDOH) – Buffalo 2024 is taking place once again in the City of Good Neighbors. This year, over 1,200 volunteers will serve 100 families with free home repairs in the Ellicott District from July 20th to July 27th.

This is the 5th annual outreach for EDOH in the City of Buffalo. Since 2019, over 1,249 families in 4 different districts have received free home repairs. Each year, thousands of volunteers come together in partnership with over 60 local churches, businesses, and nonprofits to build a better Buffalo together!
