**EIGHT DAYS OF HOPE DEPLOYS RAPID RESPONSE TEAM TO
SOUTHEAST TEXAS FLOODING**

Tupelo, MS – Eight Days of Hope (EDOH) is deploying its Rapid Response Ministry to Southeast Texas following the intense flooding that has occurred over the past week.

Already, over 800 structures have been impacted, and the waters are still receding. Hundreds of families are now beginning the long process of recovery as they navigate gutting their homes, sorting belongings, and facing uncertain circumstances.

“Texas, we share in your pain. We see the devastation. We are ready to love and serve you in your time of need,” says Stephen Tybor III, EDOH President and CEO. “Today, we are thankful for our leaders and volunteers who are preparing to travel across the country to help bring hope to the unimaginable chaos.”
