EIGHT DAYS OF HOPE TO DEPLOY TO NORTH ARKANSAS AND SOUTH MISSISSIPPI FOLLOWING DEVASTATING TORNADO OUTBREAK

Tupelo, MS – Eight Days of Hope (EDOH) is deploying its Rapid Response Ministry to Cave City, AR, and Tylertown, MS, following devastating tornadoes. Over the weekend, a tornado outbreak stretched across the Midwest and many Southern states, leaving so many in need.

"We are heartbroken for the families who were in the path of this devastation and are hurting right alongside them," shared Steve Tybor, EDOH President and CEO. "This week, our Rapid Response team will be mobilizing to two communities to serve over multiple weeks to bring hope and help across the South."
