EIGHT DAYS OF HOPE RESPONDS TO WINTER STORM FERN

Tupelo, MS—Eight Days of Hope (EDOH) is deploying its Mass Feeding Arm to multiple communities in Northeast Mississippi after winter storm Fern caused mass power outages.

"To see the damage across the country has been humbling. Over 800,000 homes are without power, and many properties have seen significant damage due to the storm. From Maine to Texas, the storm has affected hundreds of communities. Today, we are ready to come alongside at least three different cities and provide them with food," says Stephen Tybor, III, EDOH President and CEO.

EDOH will be partnering with three different churches in the Tupelo, New Albany and Blue Mountain, Mississippi areas. EDOH will be providing hot meals starting at noon on Tuesday, January 27th. These meals will be available at First Baptist Church in Tupelo, Hillcrest Baptist Church in New Albany and at the Fire Department in Blue Mountain. "These communities are not far from our National Headquarters in Pontotoc, MS, and when we see a need, we go, no matter how far or how close. We are also working on plans to deploy our Rapid Response arm as well. Hopefully we will announce those details in the next day or two," says Chandler Gurley, EDOH Vice President.
