
Dear Friend of Eight Days of Hope,



JANUARY

Los Angeles, CA | Wildfires Disaster Relief | Jan. 9 to March 6

Throughout January, a total of 14 wildfires impacted Los Angeles, destroying more than 18,000 homes and structures. We raised funds to support those in need and distributed these later in the year (see page 7).



Haywood County, NC & Valdosta, GA | Hurricane Helene Disaster Relief | Jan. 16 to Jan. 17


Hurricane Helene made landfall on September 26, 2024, and for several weeks after the storm, we were able to provide relief through our Rapid Response and Mass Feeding Ministries. We returned to the communities we had previously served in January of 2025 to provide additional relief through the delivery of donated kitchen appliances.



FEBRUARY

Bear Branch, KY | Flooding Rapid Response HEAVY | Feb. 21 to March 1

On the weekend of February 15, Eastern Kentucky experienced severe rainfall that led to intense flooding. We deployed our Rapid Response HEAVY team to Bear Branch, Kentucky, to serve for eight days. During our response, the volunteers served 20 families - completing projects including mold prevention and remediation, sorting debris, removing mud, salvaging belongings, and more!



A Father's Blessing

Ms. Janice had found her father's beloved Bible destroyed in the flood. The Bible had spent a significant amount of time covered in muddy water, and she knew it couldn't be saved. The only option, in her mind, was to throw out the Bible along with the other unsalvageable items. But she couldn't stop thinking about it. The next day, she went and pulled it out of the trash, hoping to dry it out the best she could. When she located the Bible and picked it up, it was dry - not just a few pages, but all of them!

MARCH

Cave City, AR | Tornado Rapid Response | March 19 to April 1

A tornado outbreak tore across the Midwest over the weekend of March 14. The damage was widespread, crossing multiple communities. Our Rapid Response Ministry deployed to Cave City, Arkansas, where we had the chance to tarp roofs, remove trees, and serve 53 families in the aftermath of this devastating storm!

Tylertown, MS | Tornado Rapid Response | March 19 to April 5

The same tornado outbreak that impacted Cave City, Arkansas, also damaged Tylertown, Mississippi. Our Rapid Response Ministry deployed a second team to Tylertown. Volunteers from across the country gathered for two weeks to serve 55 families with debris sorting, tree removal, roof tarping, and more!



APRIL

Sioux Falls, SD | Call to Freedom Safe House | April 2 to April 16

Over 40 skilled volunteers traveled to Sioux Falls, South Dakota, to help Call to Freedom renovate much needed office space as they continue to work tirelessly to serve survivors of trafficking in their community. Since they started several years ago, they have worked out of multiple locations, and for the first time, they can finally work together in a singular place to better help those impacted by trafficking.



Greenwood, MS | Tornado Rapid Response HEAVY | April 11 to April 18

Our Rapid Response HEAVY team headed to Greenwood, Mississippi, in the aftermath of a severe tornado. Over 40 volunteers from across the country joined us throughout the week. We provided significant tree removal, roof tarping, debris clean-up and more for 63 families in need!



MAY

Los Angeles, CA | Wildfires Mass Feeding | May 5 to May 10

Earlier in 2025, we raised funds for those impacted by the devastating wildfires that impacted much of the area around Los Angeles, California.

In May, our Mass Feeding Ministry had the chance to return and work with Lake Avenue Church in Pasadena, California. Over several days, we participated in a variety of outreaches, including hosting dinners for first responders and families impacted; sifting through fire debris in homes still untouched in the fire's aftermath; and ministering to those in need on Skid Row.

On May 10, we joined together for A Night of Hope - a benefit concert for the fire victims featuring Jordan Feliz and Terrian. Through the help of so many generous donors, we provided financial support to over 100 families recovering from the fires.



MAY

Holmes County, OH | Safe Harbor Ohio Safe House | May 24 to June 7

Our Safe House Ministry returned to Safe Harbor Ohio to start Phase 2 of construction, which included a gymnasium, commercial kitchen, beauty salon, and additional cottage space.

St. Louis, MO | Tornado Mass Feeding | May 19 to May 24

An EF-3 tornado left 30,000 people without power in St. Louis, Missouri. Our Mass Feeding Ministry responded, and over several days, we provided 3,762 meals to those in need!

London, KY | Tornado Rapid Response | May 23 to June 7

Almost 250 volunteers joined us in London, Kentucky, following a tornado. Over two weeks, we brought hope to 90 families as they faced unimaginable circumstances.



JUNE

Holmes County, OH | Safe Harbor Ohio Safe House | June 21 to July 2

The work on Phase 2 of Safe Harbor Ohio continued in June as we returned with almost 80 volunteers for our second building blitz of the year. Over two weeks, we made progress on the gymnasium, salon, and cottage spaces, putting us ahead of our estimated schedule!



Wheeling, WV | Flooding Rapid Response | June 22 to July 5

Flash flooding devastated the community of Wheeling, West Virginia, and the surrounding areas. Hundreds of volunteers joined us in removing debris, mucking out homes, providing mold remediation, and loving on families in need. Throughout the two weeks in Wheeling, we had the chance to bring hope to over 80 families!



JULY

Kerrville, TX | Flooding Rapid Response HEAVY | July 12 to July 22

On July 4, flash flooding covered much of the Texas Hill Country. The waters rose quickly displacing hundreds of people and taking the lives of so many precious individuals, including dozens of young children. The aftermath left first responders overwhelmed as they looked for survivors and those missing. For the first time ever, our team headed to Texas to participate in active search and recovery, working with local teams to provide support where needed.



JULY

Hunt, TX | Flooding Mass Feeding | July 19 to August 2

Our Mass Feeding Ministry headed to Hunt, Texas, in the aftermath of the deadly July 4 flooding that occurred in the Texas Hill Country. The loss of life was catastrophic. Many first responders and locals worked tirelessly to recover victims, clear roads, and begin rebuilding homes and lives. We were humbled to aid this heartbroken community over the course of two weeks by providing roughly 6,400 meals.



AUGUST

Holmes County, OH | Safe Harbor Ohio Safe House | August 9 to August 23

Our hope was to complete Phase 2 of construction at Safe Harbor Ohio over the course of four two-week blitzes, but God had other plans! Through an outpouring of volunteers, we were able to wrap up Phase 2 in just three two-week blitzes, completing a gymnasium, beauty salon, commercial kitchen, and additional cottage space. Our God is so good!



AUGUST

Houston, TX | Elijah Rising Safe House | August 16 to August 30

For the first time, our Safe House Ministry deployed to two locations at the same time. While serving in Ohio, we sent another team to serve our first ever Safe House Partner, Elijah Rising, in Houston, Texas. We completed renovations on their transitional housing to help survivors combat the rising cost of rent as they start life outside of the restoration program.



SEPTEMBER

Northeast, MS | Transformation Garden Safe House | Sept. 8 to Sept. 12

Our Safe House Ministry was grateful to return to another past partner, Transformation Garden, to provide upgrades to their current safe home, located in Northeast Mississippi. A small volunteer team renovated storage space to better serve the needs of this growing ministry!



OCTOBER

Memphis, TN | A Way Out Ministries Safe House | Oct. 19 to Oct. 25

In October, our Safe House Ministry brought a specialized team to A Way Out Ministries, just outside of Memphis, Tennessee, to help lay foundational work for an expansion at The Meadow. Our team helped build the first building, a social enterprise where survivors can work, on The Meadow's campus in March of 2023!







ANNUAL GALA

This December, we celebrated 20 years of hope at our 3rd Annual Gala in Tupelo, Mississippi. It was a wonderful evening of fellowship and worship with our dear friend, Ben Fuller. 

Our new facility will feature a state-of-the-art commercial kitchen to support our Mass Feeding Ministry. It will also include increased warehouse space for our trucks, trailers, and heavy equipment. Additionally, the expansion will include a larger training center to meet the needs of our growing leadership team. We are thankful for God's provision in this project as we strive to continue to love and serve those in need in His name!


Spend time regularly in prayer for EDOH and our four arms of ministry as we expand our reach. Pray that God would be glorified through all we do.
